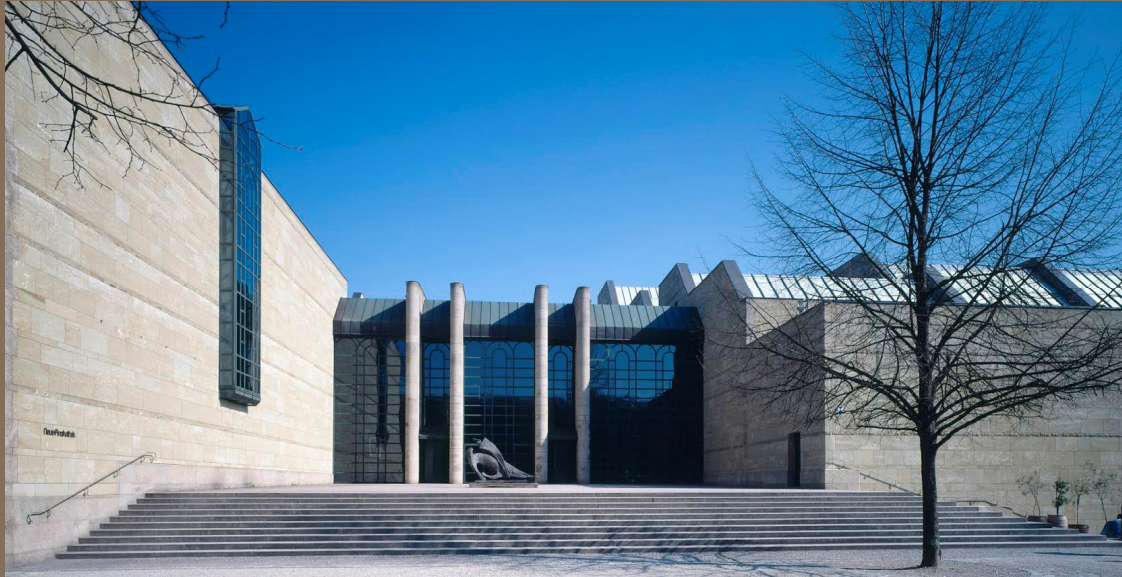

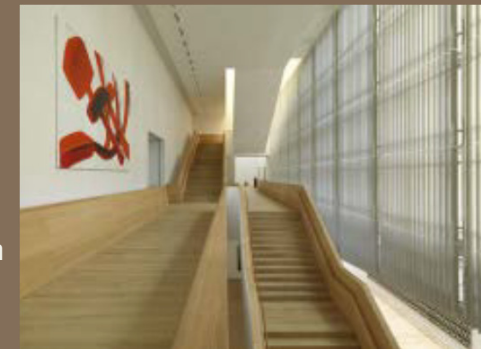

## STÄDTISCHE GALERIE IM LENBACHHAUS



The Städtische Galerie im Lenbachhaus is a municipal museum that resides in the historic villa of the “prince of painters” Franz von Lenbach. In 1957, Gabriele Münter gave over a thousand works by the Blue Rider artists like Wassily Kandinsky to the Lenbachhaus, turning the museum into a museum of world significance.

Remodeled and reopened in May 2013 one can experience this outstanding collection at Lenbachhaus or at Kunstbau - an exhibition space under ground, in a subway station. Other foci include the art of the nineteenth century, classic modernism, postwar modernism, and contemporary art.

In 2015, the new Munich Documentation Centre for the History of National Socialism opened as a place of education and remembrance.

As the place where the NSDAP was founded, Munich is associated more than any other German city with the rise of National Socialism. The Documentation Centre has been built on the site of the former ‚Brown House‘, once the headquarters of the National Socialist German Workers‘ Party (NSDAP).

**DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP**



The concentration camp memorial at Dachau was erected in 1965 following an initiative and plans from the Comité International de Dachau and financed by the state of Bavaria. It includes the grounds of the former prisoners' camp and the camp crematorium.

The Residenz (palace) in Munich's city center was once the city castle of the Bavarian dukes, princes, and emperors.

With the Residence, Munich owns one of Europe's most significant interior decoration museums.

The highlight of the Residence is the Antiquarium: the largest and most beautiful Renaissance hall north of the Alps was built around 1570.

Treasury of the Residence offers unique gold work from the Middle Ages right through to the classicism period.

# NYPHENBURG PALACE



The baroque palace in the west part of Munich was the summer residence of the Bavarian monarchs. With its lavishly decorated interior and the famous "Gallery of Beauties" commissioned by Ludwig I, the palace is one of Munich's favorite attractions.

# NEW TOWN HALL (NEUES RATHAUS)



The Glockenspiel in the tower balcony of the Neues Rathaus is world famous and worth seeing. Since 1908, figurines representing stories from Munich's history twirl on two levels daily at 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 5:00 p.m. (the 5:00 p.m. show is omitted from November through February).

At the top of the 85-meter-high (255 feet) tower on the city hall is an observation deck that can be accessed with an elevator and offers a grandiose view of the roofs of the city, even as far as the Alps in nice weather.

# CATHEDRAL CHURCH OF OUR LADY (FRAUENKIRCHE)



Both onion domes of the Gothic cathedral and city parish church known as the Frauenkirche are an unmistakable symbol of the city of Munich. The south tower of the cathedral can be climbed and offers a unique, wide view across the rooftops of Munich and on to the Alps. In the entrance of this imposing late-Gothic interior you encounter among other things the legendary devil's footprint in the floor of the church.

## NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE

The royal castle of Ludwig II near Füssen is one of the most visited castles and fortresses in Europe.

In addition to the king's luxuriously furnished living and presentation rooms, rooms furnished in medieval style for the servants and the historic kitchen can also be viewed.

Next to Neuschwanstein Castle you can also visit Hohenschwangau Castle which is in the same area and was also the home of king Ludwig during his childhood.

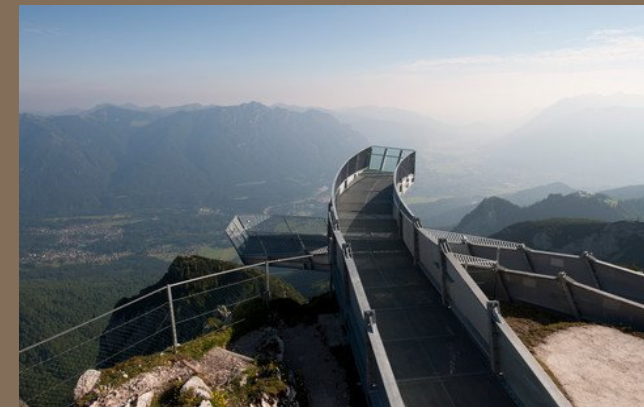
# ZUGSPITZE (GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN)



The feeling of being at the top of the snow-covered Zugspitze (highest mountain of Germany), is an experience not only for experienced mountaineers. The cable car whisks families with children, senior citizens and wheelchair users quickly and comfortably to almost 3,000 metres above sea level.

Sophisticated Garmisch with its pedestrian zone has traditional shops, but also well-known brands and trendy boutiques.

Just above the summit station of the Alpspitzbahn cable car (next to Zugspitze), two steel beams form a floating X over a vertical drop of almost 1,000 metres.

# KEHLSTEINHAUS (EAGLES NEST)



The road leading from Obersalzberg (formerly Hitler's home and southern headquarters) to the Eagle's Nest parking lot is considered to be a feat of engineering. The Eagle's Nest remained unscathed from the bombing of the Allied Forces during World War II. Since 1952 it has been open to the public as a mountain top restaurant with a spectacular view and is accessed only by special mountain buses from Obersalzberg.

Due to its high elevation the Eagle's Nest is open in summer only, usually from about mid-May through October.

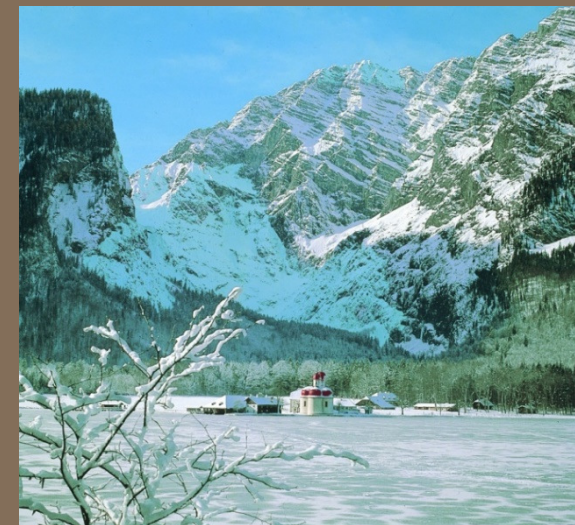

# KÖNIGSSEE



At the mouth of the Berchtesgaden National Park, surrounded by the Alps, lies Königssee. Since 1909, only electric boats have been allowed to roam the waters of this lake, hence its high drinking water quality. Boat tours are offered, which last about an hour each way, allowing passengers to get off and explore the St. Bartholomae church and Obersee, another lake at the last stop of the tour.

# SALZBURG



Salzburg is a very nice city in Austria and can be reached by car and train within two hours. The center of town is formed by the Residenzplatz square with the royal residence and the cathedral. The Mozarteum, the museum located in the house where Mozart was born and where he lived, and the Mozartplatz square are reminiscent of the artist. In Mirabell castle huge gardens and parks invite visitors to enjoy and relax.

# HERRENCHIEMSEE CASTLE



Modeled on Versailles, this palace was built as a "Temple of Fame" for King Louis XIV of France, whom the Bavarian monarch fervently admired.

The actual building of this "Bavarian Versailles", which was begun in 1878, was preceded by a total of 13 planning stages. The highlights of the large state rooms are the State Staircase, the State Bedroom and the Great Hall of Mirrors.
