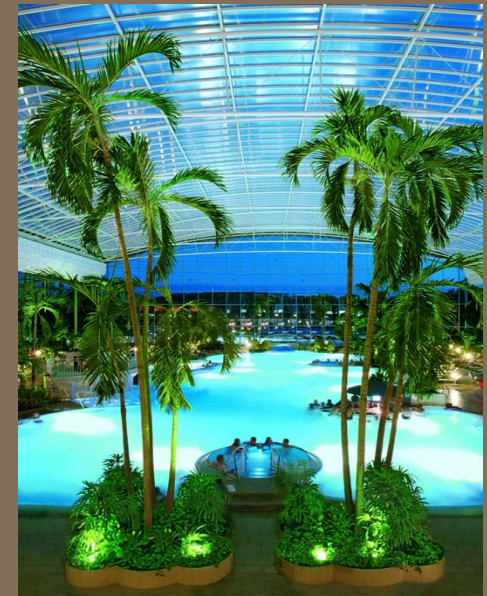

Adventure rides, amusement parks, tranquil train and boat rides through beautiful nature and mock palaces, a petting zoo - Bayern Park a short drive from Munich has plenty to appeal to kids of all interests. There are simply too many varied family activities to go into detail here, but they include Bayern-Park, an adventureland of rollercoaster heaven, the Indoor Hall Burg Fellback, a weather-proof indoor adventure park, white-water rafting, climbing Mount Zugspitze, donkey rides, trampolines and train rides.

DEUTSCHES MUSEUM VERKEHRSZENTRUM



On the Theresienhöhe, overlooking the Oktoberfest grounds, the Deutsches Museum presents its unique collection of land vehicles: from racing cars to steam locomotives, from penny-farthings to ICE trains – here you can learn all about how people have travelled around the world through the ages. The three listed exhibition halls date from 1908 and are dedicated to urban transport, travel and mobility. Visitors can see the steam locomotive “Puffing Billy” and ride in a carriage along a bumpy road in the simulator. A highlight of the collection is the world’s first gasoline car

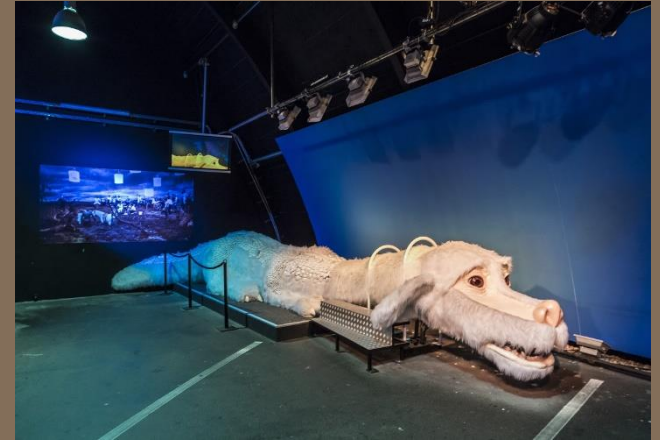

BAVARIA FILMSTADT

NEW TOWN HALL (NEUES RATHAUS)



The Glockenspiel in the tower balcony of the Neues Rathaus is world famous and worth seeing. Since 1908, figurines representing stories from Munich's history twirl on two levels daily at 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 5:00 p.m. (the 5:00 p.m. show is omitted from November through February).

At the top of the 85-meter-high (255 feet) tower on the city hall is an observation deck that can be accessed with an elevator and offers a grandiose view of the roofs of the city, even as far as the Alps in nice weather.

KIDS ACTIVITIES IN MUNICH PALAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM



The Palaeontological Museum Munich is a museum that forms part of the Bavarian Natural History Collections. It invites you to visit plants and animals from ancient times, the world of dinosaurs, extinct elephants and sabre-toothed tigers. The highlight of the museum is the 7th specimen of the first bird *Archaeopteryx* from the Solnhofen limestones. The “Fossil of the Month” features extraordinary fossils from the treasury of the collections. Guided tours and special exhibitions complete the exhibitions. In addition, multimedia presentations are given on Sundays.

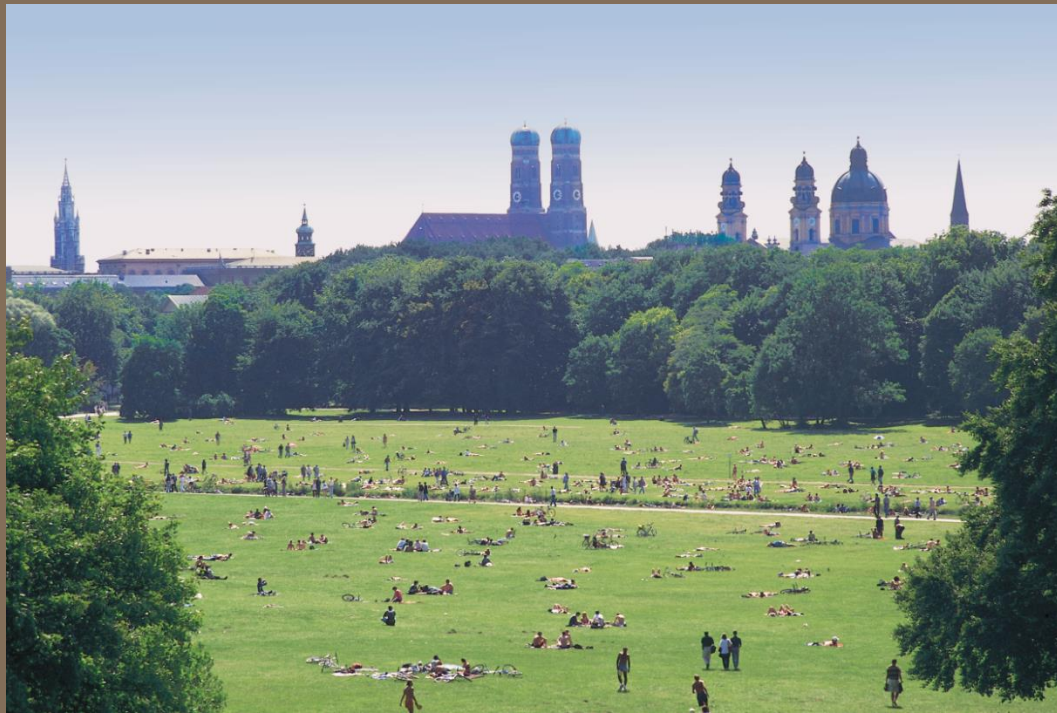

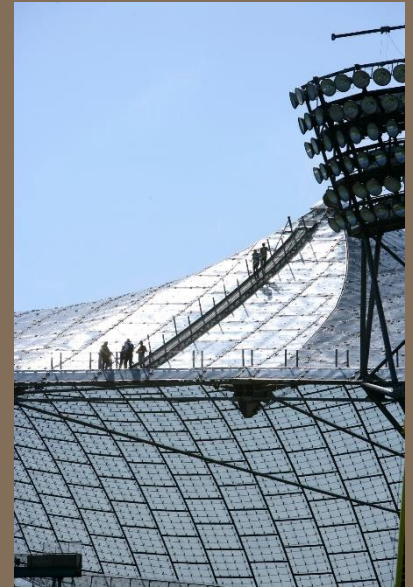

The Olympic Park was created as a scenic addition to a magnificent architecture for the 1972 Olympic Games. Here you can enjoy the view of Munich and the surrounding countryside from the Olympic Tower, take a tour of the famous tent roof, lie in the meadows or sail across Olympic Lake in a pedal boat.

The Sea-Life Center, an aquarium and zoo with more than 10,000 different aquatic creatures, is very popular with families.

NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE

The royal castle of Ludwig II near Füssen is one of the most visited castles and fortresses in Europe.

In addition to the king's luxuriously furnished living and presentation rooms, rooms furnished in medieval style for the servants and the historic kitchen can also be viewed.

Next to Neuschwanstein Castle you can also visit Hohenschwangau Castle which is in the same area and was also the home of king Ludwig during his childhood.

KIDS ACTIVITIES IN MUNICH

ZUGSPITZE (GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN)



The feeling of being at the top of the snow-covered Zugspitze (highest mountain of Germany), is an experience not only for experienced mountaineers. The cable car whisks families with children, senior citizens and wheelchair users quickly and comfortably to almost 3,000 metres above sea level.

Sophisticated Garmisch with its pedestrian zone has traditional shops, but also well-known brands and trendy boutiques.

Just above the summit station of the Alpseilbahn cable car (next to Zugspitze), two steel beams form a floating X over a vertical drop of almost 1,000 metres.

KÖNIGSSEE



At the mouth of the Berchtesgaden National Park, surrounded by the Alps, lies Königssee.

Since 1909, only electric boats have been allowed to roam the waters of this lake, hence its high drinking water quality. Boat tours are offered, which last about an hour each way, allowing passengers to get off and explore the St. Bartholomae church and Obersee, another lake at the last stop of the tour.

SALZBURG



Salzburg is a very nice city in Austria and can be reached by car and train within two hours. The center of town is formed by the Residenzplatz square with the royal residence and the cathedral. The Mozarteum, the museum located in the house where Mozart was born and where he lived, and the Mozartplatz square are reminiscent of the artist. In Mirabell castle huge gardens and parks invite visitors to enjoy and relax.

HERRENCHEMSEE CASTLE



Modeled on Versailles, this palace was built as a "Temple of Fame" for King Louis XIV of France, whom the Bavarian monarch fervently admired.

The actual building of this "Bavarian Versailles", which was begun in 1878, was preceded by a total of 13 planning stages. The highlights of the large state rooms are the State Staircase, the State Bedroom and the Great Hall of Mirrors.
